Review: Timeline for a Ballot Issue

	May 2, 2023 Ballot <i>(Dec. OFCC Meeting)</i>
Informally decide on master plan and whether to segment	September 5, 2022
Board of Education deadline to approve OFCC resolution	October 11, 2022
File resolutions with Board of Elections	February 1, 2023

Option 2

K-4 Elementary Schools

(sample student capacity by building)

- Fernway – 300 students – Site Area = 2.39 acres
- Ludlow – 350 students – Site Area = 3.45 acres
- Mercer – 482 students – Site Area = 8.95 acres
- Lomond – 482 students – Site Area = 8.75 acres
- Middle Years (Grades 5-8) – 1,362 students
- High School – 1,376 students

Note: All enrollment numbers are based on 2026/27 projections from the OFCC

Option 2 With Four K-5 Elementaries

(sample student capacity by building)

- Fernway – 300 students – Site Area = 2.39 acres
- Ludlow – 350 students – Site Area = 3.45 acres
- Mercer – 650 students – Site Area = 8.95 acres
- Lomond – 650 students – Site Area = 8.75 acres
- Middle Years (Grades 6-8) – 1,029 students
- High School – 1,376 students

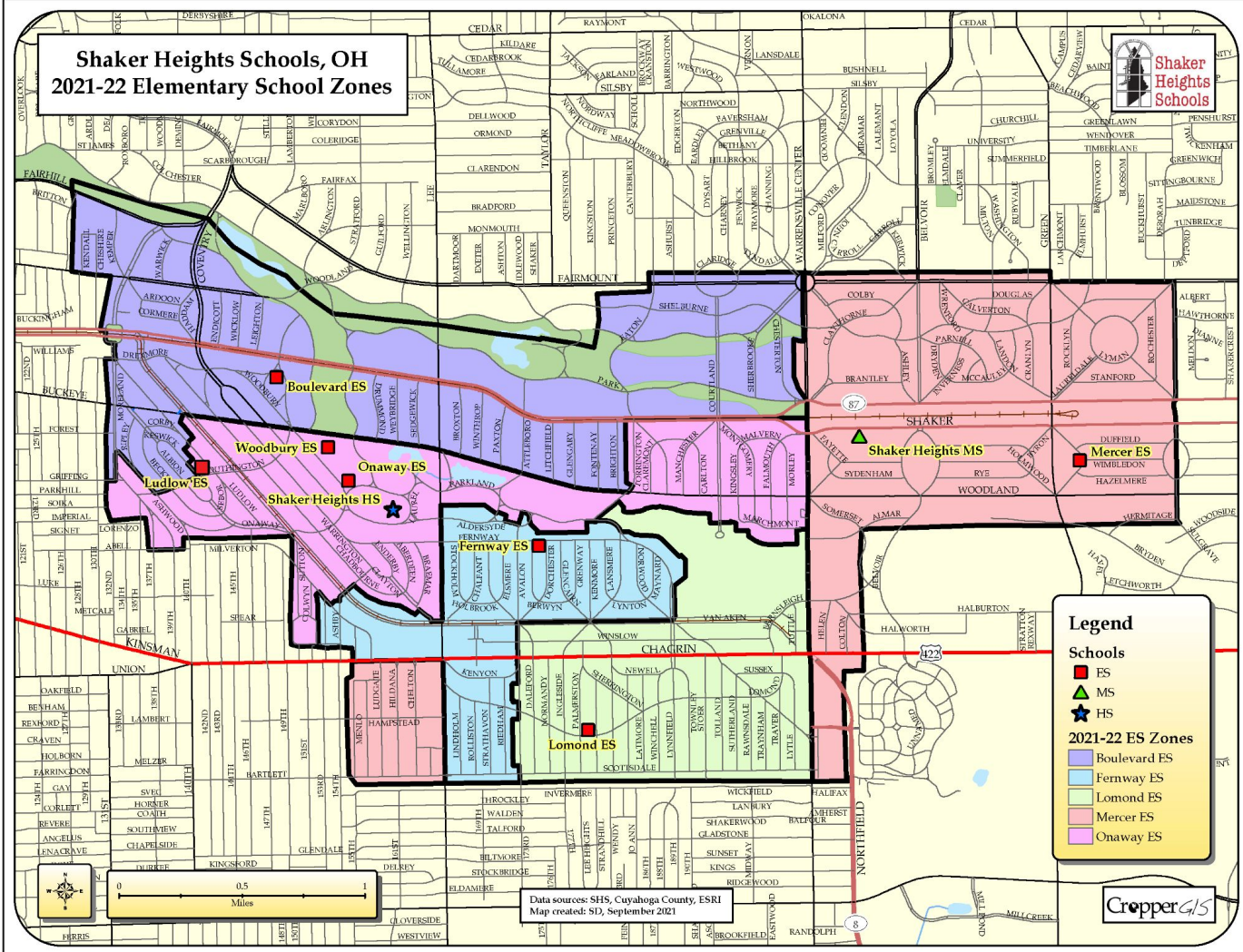
PreK-5 Elementary Schools

(sample student capacity by building, PreK enrollment not included)

- Fernway – 300 students – Site Area = 2.39 acres
- Ludlow – 350 students – Site Area = 3.45 acres
- Mercer – 433 students – Site Area = 8.95 acres
- Lomond – 433 students – Site Area = 8.75 acres
- Boulevard – 433 students – Site Area = 5.1 acres
- Middle Years (Grades 6-8) – 1,029 students
- High School – 1,376 students

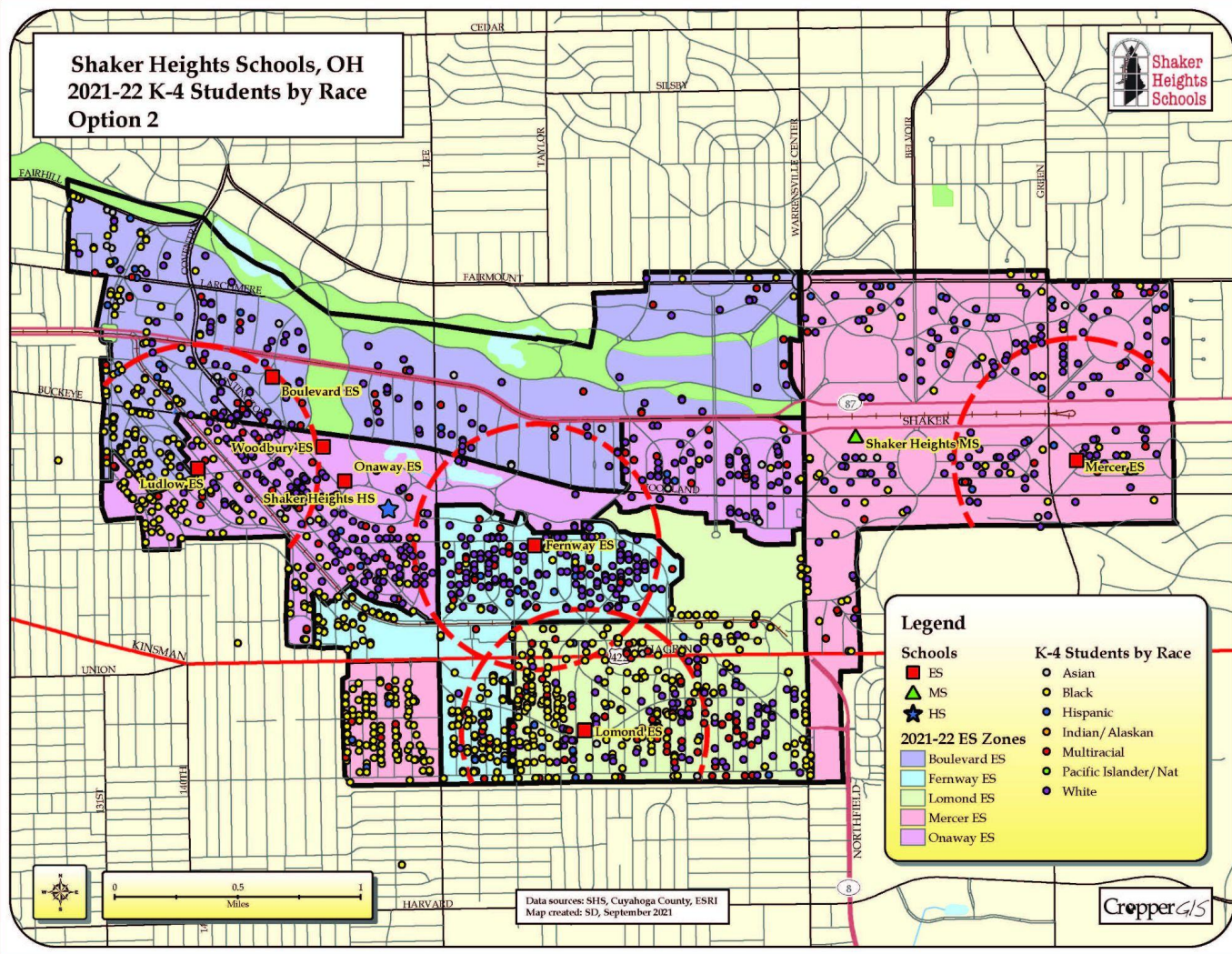

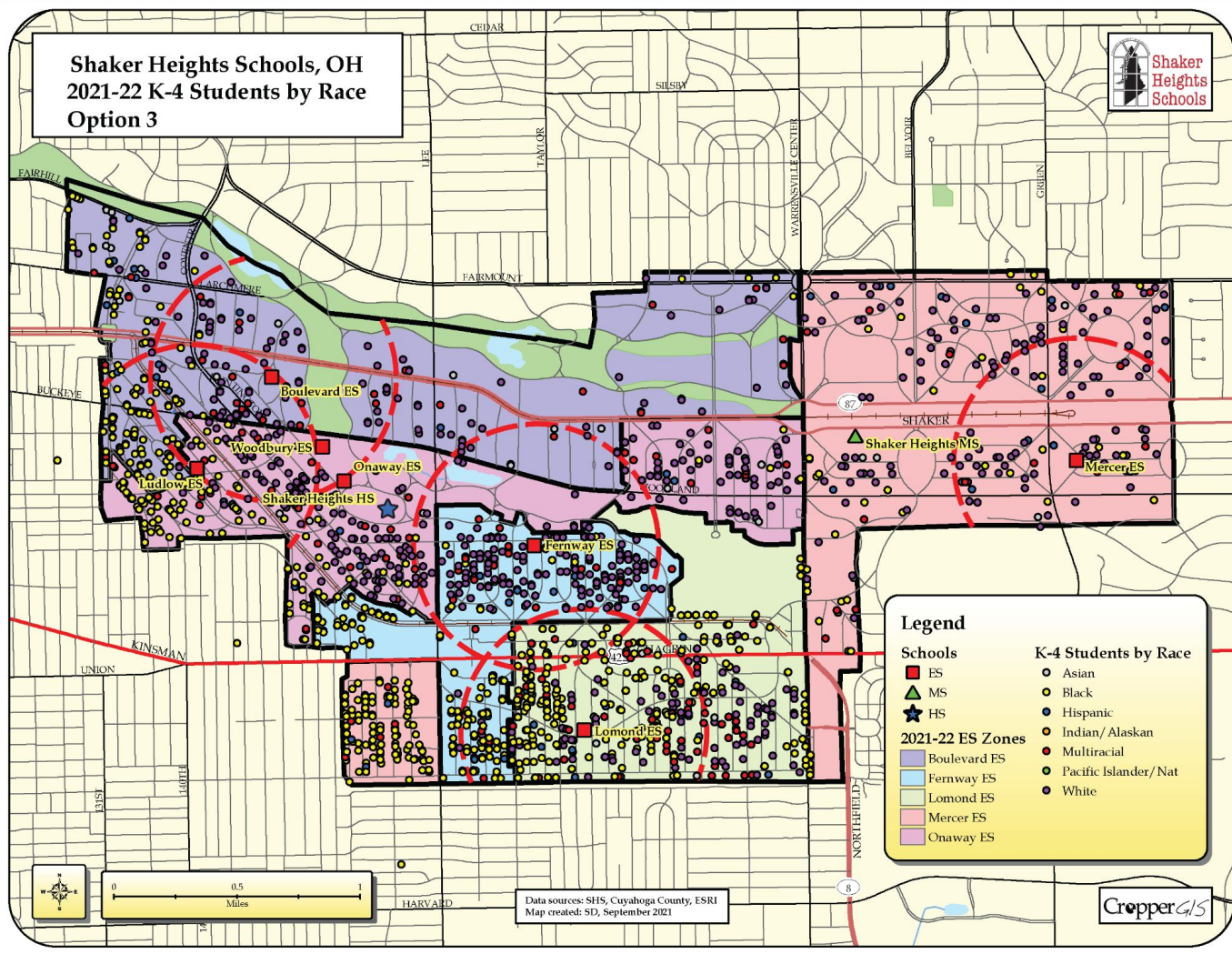
